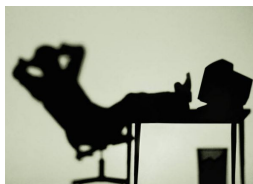
Although any day is a good day to thank the people who make projects successful, IPM Day is always the first Thursday in November.
